Mrs. Lilley will also accept a photo taken at home for the yearbook. If this option is for you, please take a photo following these guidelines:



#### **Home Portrait Guidelines:**

- Plain Light or White Background**
- Shoulders slightly turned (not facing fully forward)**
- Plenty of space above head to allow for cropping**
- Rule of thumb: Student's chin should be in the very center of the picture**

# PICTURE DAY Q & A

What time does my child take their school picture?

- Students should arrive on time for the time slot you chose using the link.

What if I have multiple children that need to take a picture?

- Please choose a time on the link and change the quantity for the number of children you are bringing to take their school picture.

Where do we go when we arrive?

- Please arrive on time for your time slot and come to the sign in table in front of the flagpole.
- You will receive a card with your child's name to give to the photographer.

Can I come in with my child during their picture?

- Unfortunately, to maintain a safe environment, parents will not be able to enter the multi-purpose room for pictures. There will be a designated waiting area for parents to wait for their children to finish with their pictures.

Does my child need to wear a mask?

- Yes. All students, staff and parents on campus will need to wear a mask as they arrive for pictures. Students will be able to remove their masks for their picture.

What are the safety protocols in place for picture day?

- The photographer is placed 6 ft away from students while taking their picture and all helpers will wear masks. Students will only have their mask removed during their picture. Students will enter and exit through different doors to maintain a one-directional flow of traffic.

How long will I be waiting when I arrive?

- We ask that everyone arrives on time for their time slot to ensure no one has to wait longer than it takes to take the photo.

How can I purchase pictures?

- You can order one of two ways:
